
- Antea Cement is successfully certified with OHSAS 18001, a Certificate on Health and Safety at Work

PS2 foresees the provision of a job which guarantees the workers rights while paying them a decent and fair wage. During construction of the plant, 1100 contractor employees of different nationalities such as Albanian, Greek Chinese were employed and the construction was completed on time, within budget and without any Loss Time Injury.



## KPI TRAININGS HOURS 2010-2014

At ANTEA cement, we have in place a yearly training program. Specific topics are chosen in order to ensure that proper and adequate HS training is provided to all personnel at our facilities and that our activities are in accordance with the Albanian legislation regarding Health and Safety at Work. Trainings are delivered in weekly basis and include also the daily contractors. Following these regularly-scheduled training, employees received 2361 hours of training while 596 training hours were organized for our daily contractors.
